The University of Technology of Troyes, in collaboration with the Interdisciplinary Research Team on the Transition Towards Socio-technical Sustainable Systems (CREIDD), the Institute of Services and Industry of the Future of Troyes (ISIFT) and the Chaire Connected Innovation, invite you to make part of the **Workshop PubliER 2020: How can the Industries of the Future contribute to address the forthcoming challenges of our society?** to be held on the 29–31 of January, 2020 in Troyes, France.

This high-level workshop is dedicated to refining the scientific academic writing skills of top-end early researchers. The aim is to enable the researchers to build the writing and publishing capacities to mature and polish previously written papers and publish them on the most pertinent international scientific journals. The authors will also develop managerial skills allowing them to successfully publish their high-quality content in the most relevant journals in their fields of study.

Objective

The concept of this workshop is to peer a selection of authors of the ‘best articles, presented during international conferences in different disciplines, with top-quality editors from international scientific journals. During the three days of the workshop, the researchers will participate of tailored advising sessions and other activities guided by the panel of editors. That process will enable the researchers to better previously written articles and end with a



top-quality product. The early researchers will also participate as peer reviewers for at least other two proposed articles participating in the workshop.

The participants will develop a “know-how” on scientific writing and publishing enabling them to communicate highly relevant content on the most pertinent international journals. Both, early researchers and editors, will benefit of the space created by the workshop to share ideas, discuss, and expand their professional network in a pluri-disciplinary environment.

What we offer

As author of one of the best articles presented in an international conference, we invite you to engage in personalised sessions with editors of international journals in order to take your article to the next level. With help of the other 'best-articles' authors (peer reviewers) and journal editors, the idea is for you to get out of the workshop with a top-quality paper ready to submit to the top international journals in your field of study.

On top of that, you will be participating as a peer reviewer or other articles. You will gain experience as a reviewer during the workshop sessions. Once you register and submit your article, you will be assigned 3 abstracts to review.

If you're up to reviewing other high-quality papers, and ready to be reviewed by an international panel of journal editors and peer reviewers, then PubliER is the place to be.

Each session (labelled as 'presentation of articles' in the programme) will last from 60 to 75 minutes and will follow the following structure:

1. Presentation of the article by the author. 15 minutes



2. Feedback first peer reviewer. 5-10 minutes
3. Feedback second peer reviewer. 5-10 minutes
4. Open discussion. 25 minutes
5. Feedback and closing remarks by editor. 10 minutes

As part of the workshop you will be able to attend to lectures/presentations of 45 minutes presented by keynote speakers on subjects around the following questions:

- How to structure a scientific article
- How to formalise the main idea of your article
- How to choose the right title and keywords of your article
- How to manage the revision process of your article
- How to choose the right journal for publication
- How does the revision process work
- How to do effective peer reviewing
- ...

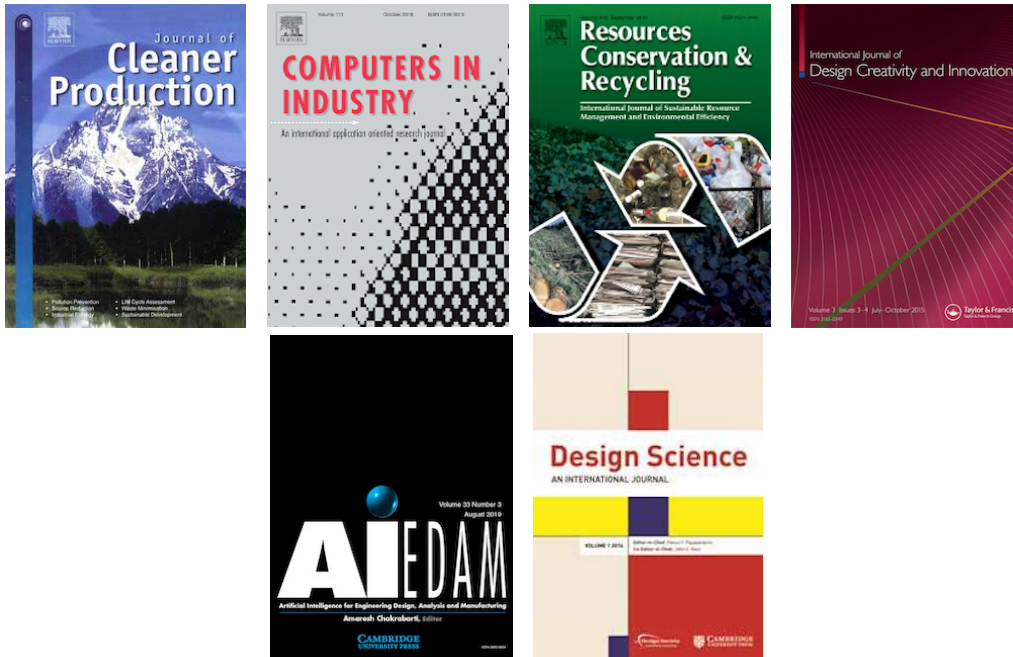
